



Golden Junior Hockey Society (the “Society”) – Bursary Application

Application Deadline – March 31, 2022

Eligibility

Golden Rockets players during the 2021-2022 playing season who will be pursuing post secondary education in the fall of 2022 may apply for a \$500.00 bursary per player to assist with education costs. There will be a maximum of 3 bursaries awarded for the playing season.

Qualifications to be considered

1. Academic achievement
2. Sportsmanship
3. Hockey participation and/or quality of contribution
4. School, community participation and service

How to Apply

1. Submit a Society – Bursary Application form to the Head Coach by March 31, 2022
2. Copy of current academic transcript
3. Reference letter from your school or teacher
4. Personal resume

Selection

A committee of the Board of Directors (the “Board”) of the Golden Junior Hockey Society will review all applications and make recommendations to the Board, who will make the final decision at their regular Board meeting regarding awards. Applicants will be notified in writing of the Board’s decision.

Payment of Bursary

Bursary recipients must provide proof of enrollment as a full-time student in a University, College, Trade or Vocational program. Cheques will be made payable to the educational institution after proof of enrollment is received by the Board. Bursary awards may be deferred until August 31, 2023, after which, if unclaimed, will expire.

Submission date

The Bursary Application form and accompanying documents must be submitted as one package, in hard copy, to the Head Coach by March 31, 2022. Final Grade 12 transcripts must be submitted as soon as possible. Confirmation of acceptance by the post secondary institution and payment instructions should be submitted as soon as received.
